Brad Davis was an All-American High School player then played for the University of Maryland's Terrapins. He was selected by the Los Angeles Lakers in the first round of the draft. He spent the last 12 seasons of his NBA career with the Mavericks and was the first player to have his number retired. In 1993, he became an assistant coach for the Mavericks and today, is the Maverick's player development coach.

Doug Saylor played point guard for Louisiana State University, establishing a single game assist record with 14 assists.
